What is 10 for Change?


- Challenge area businesses to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 10%
- Over 100 Boulder area businesses committed to reducing their energy use.
- A free and voluntary annual challenge
 - Administered by the City's Local Environmental Action Division (LEAD).



Objectives

- Assist businesses with leveraging rebates and incentives for projects
- Facilitate networking events

for businesses to share their experiences in sustainability





Development of 10 for Change

Co-founded in late 2008 through a public-private partnership between the City of Boulder, Cleantech Solutions, and local firm Hogan Lovells.

10 for Change is endorsed by Boulder City Council and our program partners:

- Boulder Chamber of Commerce
- Downtown Boulder Inc.
- Boulder Independent Business Alliance (BIBA)



Program Funding

Climate Action Plan (CAP) Tax

- Passed in November 2006
- Based on per kWh usage
- Collected through utility bill
- Customers who subscribe to wind-generated power through Xcel Energy's Windsource program are not taxed

Current CAP Tax Rates:

Electricity User Type	Tax Rate	Average Annual Tax
Residential	\$0.0049 /kWh	\$21
Commercial	\$0.0009 /kWh	\$94
Industrial	\$0.0003 /kWh	\$9,600



- Billing data collected directly from Xcel
 Energy
- Weather Normalized
- Calculated for GHG Changes
